Use critical thinking and place student wellness at the forefront of all interactions Sleep overnight in the HCU residence halls

Assist in planning and coordinating program activities

Host daily small group with attendees over apologetics and college preparedness topics

Participate in all weekly activities

Position Requirements: The desired candidate will be intentional, organized, and able to make authentic connections; adherence to HCU Code of Conduct and remain in good standing at the university; articulation of Christian faith required
